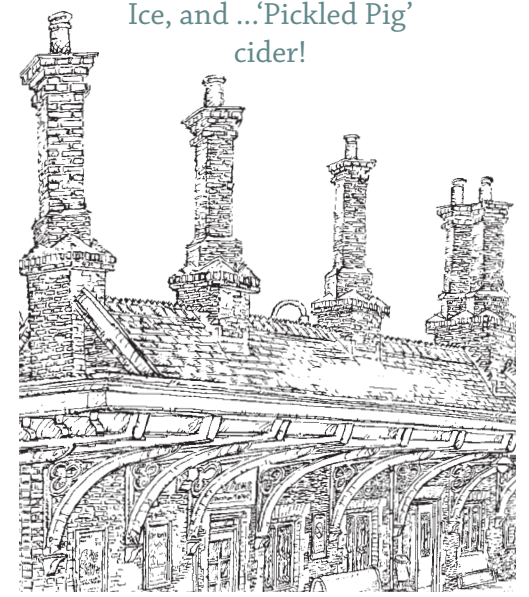

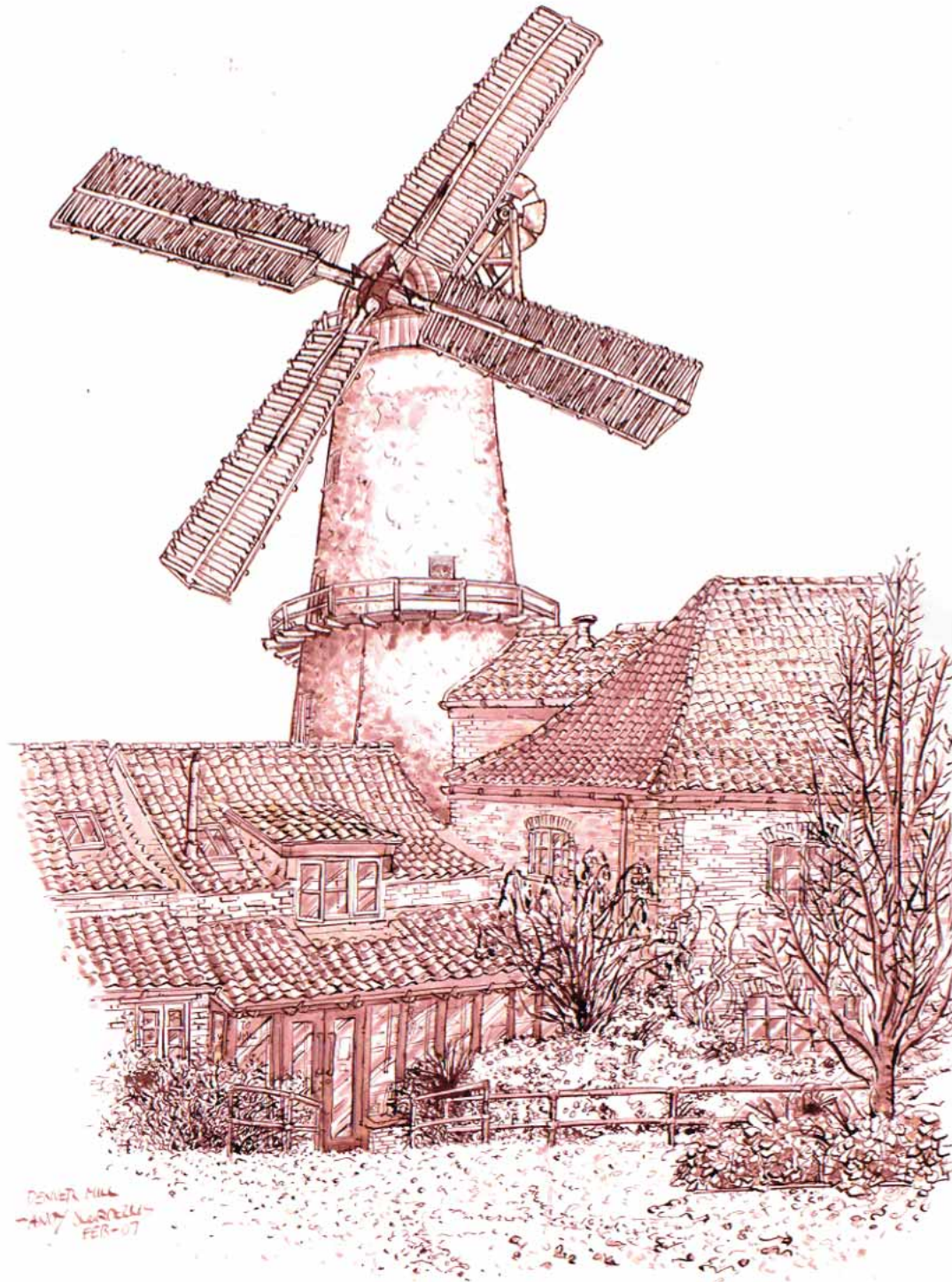
## DOWNHAM - MARKET - Railway Platform

## - DENVER - Mill Cottage

**Mill Cottage** - up the pathway from Sluice Road, amidst willow and fir, apple and pear trees, is Mill Cottage - a traditional two up two down faced with local carrstone. Denver Mill looms nearby, sails cartwheel in the low evening sun. Mill Cottage has been added to and extended over the years but retains it's rustic charm. 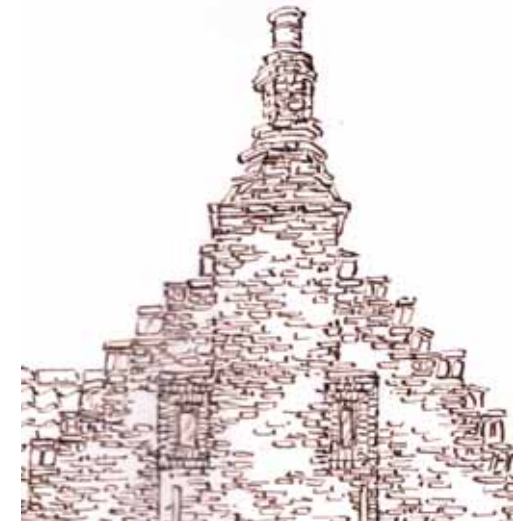

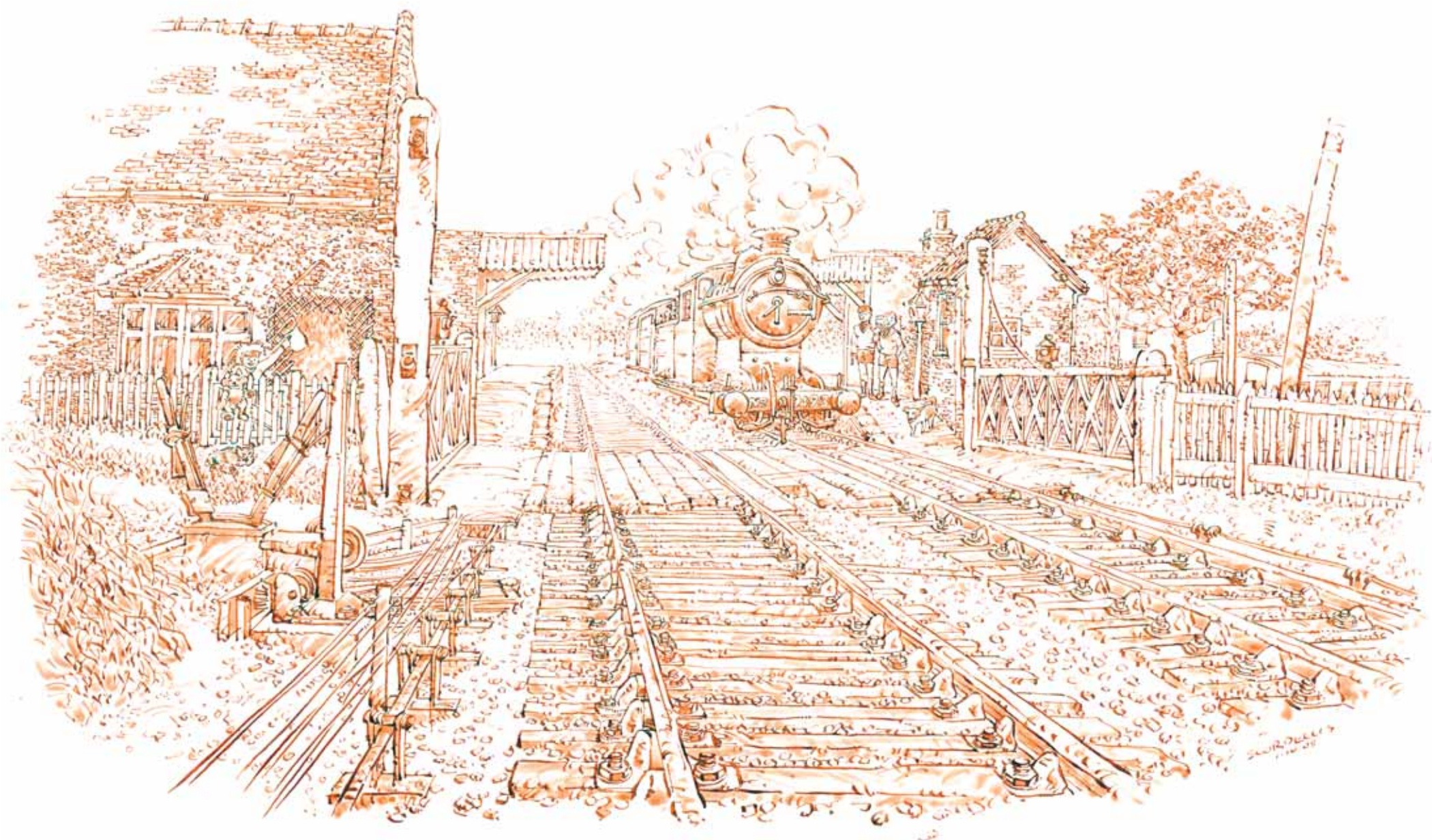
## DOWNHAM - MARKET - Priory House

**Priory House** – located at the top of Priory Road, is possibly the town’s oldest residential property being listed as 17th century. Contrary to it’s name, it is uncertain whether there is a connection to any religious order. Tales also of legendary underground tunnels leading from the cellars remain unsubstantiated. Latterly the building was a solicitors office, before becoming a private residence.

## - DENVER - Denver Junction

**Denver Junction** - a two track station - originally 'Denver Road Gate' - became a branch line for passenger trains from Downham to Stoke Ferry. The 1980's saw the track singled and the crossing automated. Polish coal, running twice weekly from Kings Lynn to Foxton, was a favourite with enthusiasts owing to the variety of locomotive power used.

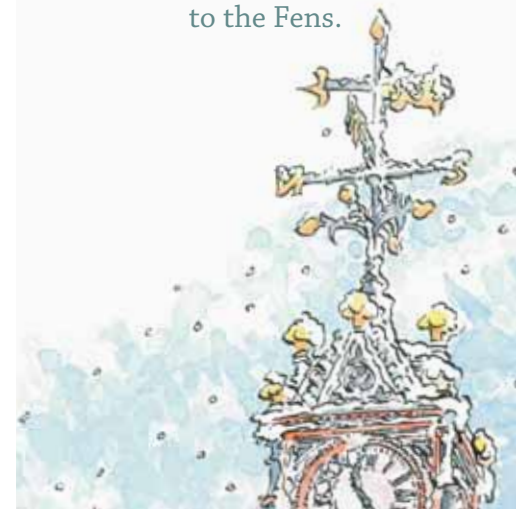

## DOWNHAM - MARKET - Clocktower

**Downham Market Clocktower** - overlooking the Town Square - was presented to the town in 1878 by Mr James Scott, a local grocer and draper. Built by William Cunliffe of London, the attractive black and white tower has a square gabled clock face with four dials, and stands at the junction of High Street and Bridge Street - formerly Market Place. Downham Market in West Norfolk is often thought of as the county's gateway... to the Fens.
